Teacher, Sarah Ellery has participated in both phase 1 and 2 of the Ready, Set, Grow program.

Five large year 2 classes learned about gardening practices in their PDHPE lessons over 5 weeks.

Due to the large number of participating classes, class teachers took their own class on the harvest exercise each week.

For a larger school, organising the care of the garden can be more of a challenge, but Sarah and the school's green team care for the garden, with help from other keen teachers and the grounds keeper.

Sarah enjoys the project and spending lunch times in the garden with the green team. She can see the value students gain from participating in the garden. In fact, she can't keep one young boy away from the garden - he spends most of his lunch breaks there making sure the compost and worm farm are going well.
